- <sup>1</sup> Complete UNIV 200 or a "computer proficiency" examination before being admitted to Upper Division.
- Students who meet criteria set by the Department of Mathematics may register for MATH 143 (Math ACT => 26-27) upon entry. Those who do not meet these qualifications must take both MATH 109 and 110 (Math ACT => 26-27), in order to satisfy the MATH 143 requirement.
   Must be selected from ANTH, ECON, GEOG, POLS, PSYC, SOCI, or CJUS with at least one 3-hour course at the 200 level or above.
- See advisor for a list of acceptable courses.
- <sup>4</sup> Must be selected from both biological (BIOL) and physical (CHEM, GEOL, PHYS) sciences. Two of these courses must be within the same science. Both a biological and a physical science must be taken. If a student chooses to take only one biological science, ENVS 150 may be used.
- <sup>5</sup> Must be selected from CMCN 100 (or 101 for international students), 202, 203 (HONR), 302, or 310.
- <sup>6</sup> Must be selected from MUS, VIAR, DANC, THEA or DSGN 121.
- <sup>7</sup> Must be taken in last semester.
- <sup>8</sup> A student must develop a Plan of Study listing the Concentration Core Courses (39 hours) with an academic advisor, in conjunction with other INFX faculty as well as faculty from the domain area of interest. The Plan of Study must be approved by INFX Program Coordinator before a student is admitted to UD.
